

Parent feedback survey 2022

- There were a total of 33 responses to the parent feedback survey in July 2022
- 100% of the responses said:-
 - Their child is happy at school
 - Their child is safe at school
 - Their child is well looked after
 - Their child is taught well and has made good progress in their learning and development
 - DNS responded to any concerns
 - DNS is well led and managed
 - Their child has benefitted from attending DNS
 - Would recommend DNS to another parent

9% said... We will ...

 Tapestry updates were good but could be more frequent.

- Tapestry is a great tool to share information with parents, however, it does detract staff away from their interactions with the children
- There is a significant amount of administration that is required to complete Tapestry regularly, and we need to ensure we balance the time for this, alongside prioritising the time for the children in the classroom
- There is no statutory obligation for us to do this at all, so therefore we are prioritising the staff and children the time in the classroom rather than writing up Tapestry observations
- We will continue to evaluate what we do and seek your feedback
- We will endeavour to share important information with you via this route

9% said... We will ...

- Would be nice for nursery to display which week is the lunch menu so parents know what the kids have had for lunch.
- More personal feedback after session eg had they eaten lunch

- We will add the Week of the menu to our weekly white boards that are then shared with you as parents – we hope this helps! The menu is a three week cycle
- We have over 40 children eating lunch each day, along with children all going home at the same time – it is not possible to share this level of information, however, we do say to parents; 'assume your child has eaten, unless you tell you otherwise' – we will always let you know if your child is struggling

 We would of liked more opportunities to visit daughter at the setting ...and also perhaps more information on how child is getting on with regards to EYFS so we can offer extra support at home
